Sir/Madam

I am directed to convey the approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Women & Child Development for total allocation of **473815 MTs** (Four lakh seventy three thousand eight hundred and fifteen only) of **Wheat [236910 MTs+236905]**, **397294 MTs** (Three lakh ninety seven thousand two hundred and ninety four only) of **Rice [198651+198643]** and **4387 MTs** (Four thousand three hundred eighty seven only) of **Maize [2194+2193]** to the State Governments/UTs as per the quantities mentioned against each, under **Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP)** for the 3rd and 4th quarter of 2014-15:-

3. The allocated foodgrains should be lifted as per the guidelines laid down vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2007-BP II dated 27.06.2011 and will be used for the beneficiaries of **ICDS Scheme only**. The State Governments are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting and utilization of foodgrains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

4. The State Governments who have not yet furnished the UC for 2013-14 are requested to furnish the **same immediately** and the offtake/UC for the foodgrains allocated for the third quarter vide this sanction by 31.01.2015. The consolidated UC for the entire quantity of foodgrains allocated during 2014-15 by 30.04.2015.

5. The State Governments are also requested to intimate the end use of the foodgrains allocated under the ICDS Scheme along with the offtake figures and UC.

6. The CIP of wheat, Rice and Coarsegrains (Maize/Jowar) for **BPL** is **Rs.415/-, Rs.565/- and Rs.300/- per quintal** respectively, which is payable by the State/UT to the FCI.

7. The State Government may indent the allocated quantity of foodgrains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of foodgrains to the State Government. In the meantime district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of foodgrains may be worked out and copies of the

same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.

8. Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Government to ensure that the quantity of foodgrains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of foodgrains released by this Ministry under WBNP.

9. State Governments of Chattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and UT of A & N Islands may be allowed to draw their allocations from the DCP stocks under Decentralised Procurement System (DCP) vide letter No.13-1/2012-BP II dated 14.02.2012 received from Department of Food & Public Distribution.

10. This issues with the approval of Secretary, MWCD, vide Dy.No.653 dated 21.10.2014.
